- Ensure that your child is treated with respect at all times;
- Let parents know when there is problem with attendance, punctuality, attitude and behaviour or any other concerns which may affect their child's work or behaviour;
- Send reading books home regularly;
- Set, mark and monitor homework (Learning Logs) each week in addition to any spelling ,reading or learning of multiplication tables (Times Tables); Learning Log tasks will be usually given to pupils on Thursday and should be returned to School by the following Tuesday;
- Arrange and give appointments to formal Parents Evenings to be held each term when the child's books
 will be available and progress can be discussed and send home an annual written report on their child's
 progress in the Summer Term;
- Ensure that all complaints are handled sensitively and responded to in line with the School's complaints procedure;
- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters.
